She communicates sensitively and clearly with all involved in the clients' care and rehabilitation and can sustain positive relationships in often difficult circumstances. This is an area of her work that she particularly relishes and has been successful in.

Her extensive experience of multi-disciplinary working stands her in good stead as a Case Manager, able to coordinate and lead a diverse team of professionals. Having worked in the NHS since qualifying, Erica has developed an ability to work creatively and flexibly with limited resources.

Along with team working, Erica has developed a person-centred and goal orientated approach, very used to writing reports and coordinating complex discharges involving both health and local authority funding. In terms of areas of expertise, Erica is called upon to utilise the full range of OT skills, but she enjoys postural management, vocational rehabilitation and fatigue management in particular.
