In addition, Ben was awarded a 1st Class BSc in Specialist Practice (Community Mental Health Nursing) which provided him with the opportunity to work for 12 months as a community psychiatric nurse.

Ben's previous experience as a case manager in the Cardiff NHS Trust Commissioning Team, where he had overall responsibility for the service user experience from referral to discharge, including individual needs assessment, funding applications, the commissioning and implementation of care packages has fed very nicely into his work as an independent Case Manager. He has specialist knowledge of the Continuing Healthcare framework, Residency Guidance, funding for '117 Aftercare' and the Mental Capacity Act.
